
This International Day of Rural Women offers us a renewed opportunity to commit to a different way of organizing our world, to build on the vision of the Feminist Plan and on the outcomes and multistakeholder commitments of the recent United Nations Food System Summit, so that rural women benefit equally from their productivity, with good food enjoyed by all.

According to a report by the United Nations, 40% of the total agricultural labour force in developing countries comprises women. In South American countries, the figure is around 20% whereas, in Asia and Africa, more than 50% of the agricultural labour force is women. But even after comprising almost half the workforce, these women do not get equal rights and share as their male counterparts. They face discrimination in access to resources, equal









The engoing Covid-19 pundemic and increasing environmental crisis have deepened the crisis of food insecurity in many parts of the world, despite nature being capable enough to produce sufficient and good quality food for everyone. The recent report by LIV Novemen states that in 2020, 23.7 billion people could not have access to adequate food. This means that around 20% or 3.2 billion people more were punhed towards hunger. Among these people, the group which fixed most of the brunt was rural women and children.

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
