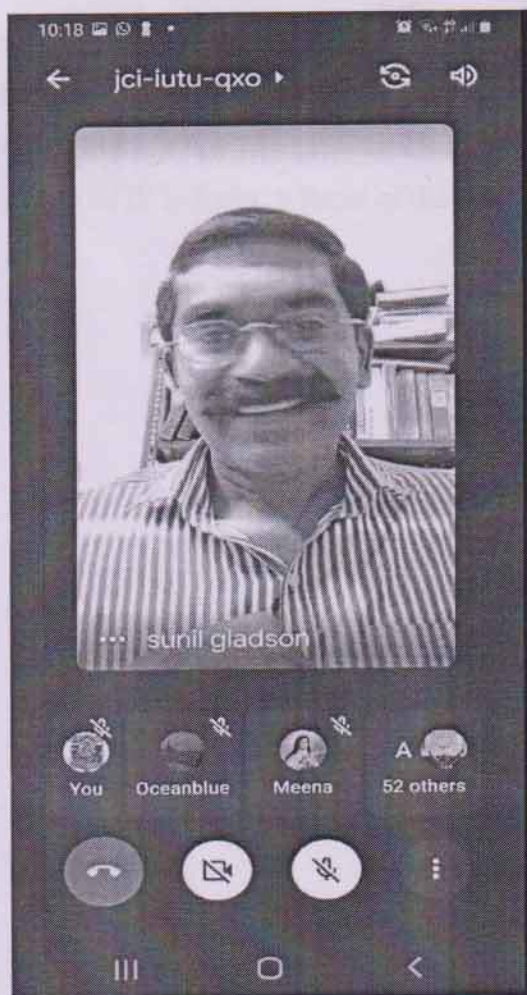
Session I

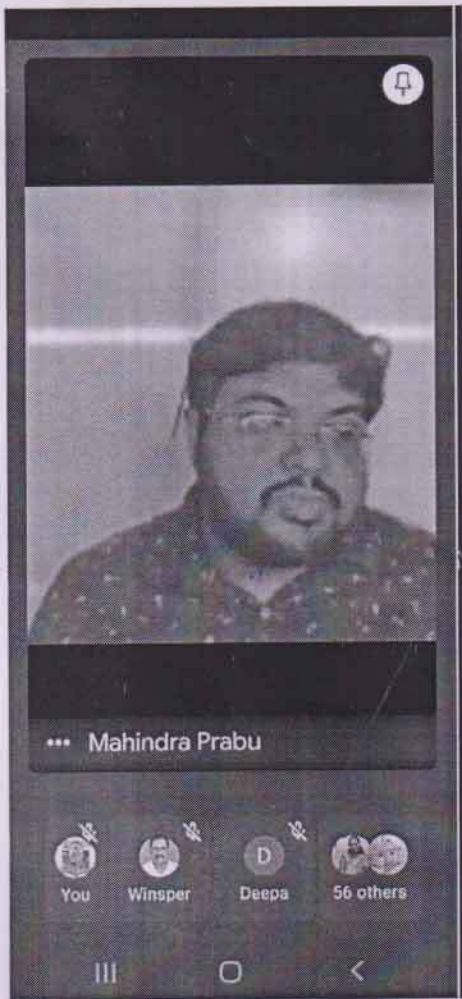

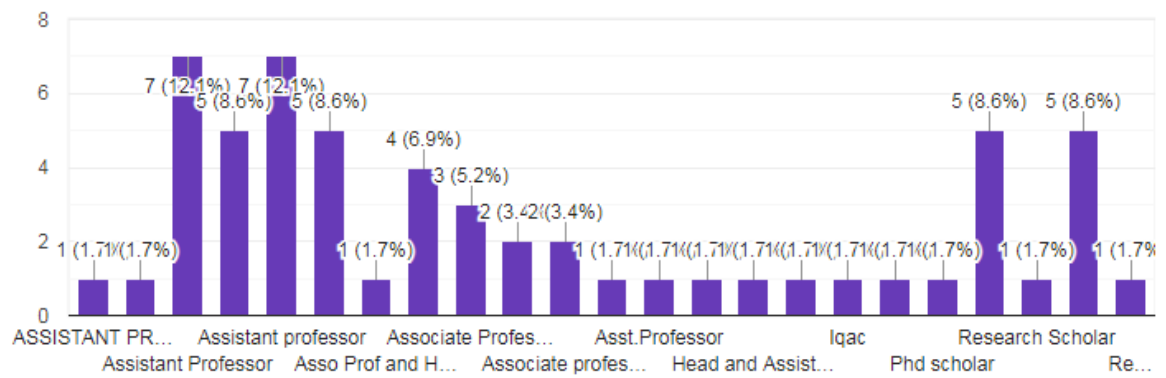
