The Seminar

The changing global environment raises questions about

the ability of traditional, small scale business in rural areas to

share the potential benefits offered by changing environment. Rural entrepreneurship is a micro-concept occupying a very limited area. It has been found very difficult to establish casual linkages, or to qualify the specific efforts of globalization on rural entrepreneurship.

The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 aims at facilitating the promotion and development and enhancing the competitiveness of micro, and medium enterprises and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. The Act provides for a statutory consultative mechanism at the national level with wide representation of all sections of stakeholders, particularly three classes of enterprises i.e. micro, small and medium enterprises, and a wide range of advisory functions. The Act also contains enabling provisions for notification of schemes/programmes for micro, small and medium enterprises, progressive credit policies and practices, preference in Government procurements to products and services of the micro and small enterprises and mechanisms for mitigating the problems of delayed payments to micro and small enterprises.

One of the challenges of rural entrepreneurs is finance. When they emerge out as an entrepreneur they don't opt for venture funding but try to go to funding for small to medium business people. Many such non-technical business people don't understand the online business models as a whole and so getting an initial business funding from them becomes challenging. Central Government is the first time Indian policymaker which has announced an agenda directly aimed at promoting start-ups and entrepreneurship.

The seminar is organised to share the knowledge of Micro Small Medium Enterprise financial system that performs its functions to set the pace for the achievement of broader national objectives. It provides a platform for facilitating interaction among students, academics, researcher to discuss the opportunities start MSMEs.




